Estimating Answers (Subtracting within 100)

Imagine you cut off 39 cm from this piece of wood.

What is an easy way to estimate the length of the piece left over?



39 is close to 40 so I just think $75 - 40$.



How could you use the same thinking to estimate $64 - 19$?
